**FOOD VENDOR INFORMATION**

**BOOTH FEE: \$400 • ADD ELECTRICITY: \$50**

**INFORMATION AND RULES:**

Booth size is 20' x 20' at a fee of \$400 the day.

Food, utensils, and equipment must be kept in a clean and sanitary condition. Food shall be stored in enclosed containers and at proper temperature.

All vendors are required to have general liability insurance.

All vendors are required to provide their own tables, chairs, power cords, tenting/canopies or any other supplies as well as any required permits and/or licenses to do business in Tennessee, as well as the proper license from Maury County Health Department in regards to food vendors.

Tents are required. Please weight your tents to withstand wind and provide stake protection.

Electricity must be requested prior to the show, for additional charge of \$50. You are responsible for your own cords; we recommend a minimum of 100 feet.

Electricity will only be provided the days of the event.

No refunds of fees will be returned for approved vendor.\*

There are no refunds in the event of inclement weather. This is a rain or shine event!

**SET-UP/ TEAR DOWN:**

All vendors may begin set up on the evening of Friday, October 6th.

All vendors must check in at the registration booth on October 7th between 7-9 a.m.

No vehicles will be allowed in the festival area after 9:00 a.m., and before 7:00 p.m., October 7th

Tear down is at 7:00 p.m., October 7th.

**PETS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN BOOTH AREA**

*\*All those NOT accepted to the show will have their booth rental fees returned to them. Only completed applications with all the required items will be processed.*
